## Carcassonne &amp; the Canal du Midi

**Tuesday the 19th of June 2012 at 9:00am - Departure by bus from Pierre Baudis Congress Centre**

*Language of the tour: English*

In the morning, Carcassonne guided tour: visit of the Cité de Carcassonne, a medieval castle fortified with two lines of citywalls, the Count's Castle and Saint-Nazaire Basilica.

Walk around the narrow lanes of « La Cité » (as it is called) and you will find a genuine medieval town surrounded by 3 kilometres of ramparts and 52 towers, as well as hotels, gift shops, leafy squares and many restaurants serving regional cuisine. Classified as a UNESCO World Heritage site in 1997, « La Cité » is visited all year long by those who want to feel history come alive. It's an exceptionally attractive place and the setting for many events.

**Lunch at 12:15pm in a restaurant in Carcassonne: a three-course menu with wine and coffee**





In the afternoon, return to Toulouse by the Canal du Midi river: you will see the Canal, Castelnaudary's big basin and multiple old locks, and the Canal supply tank of Saint-Ferréol.

**Return to Toulouse and drop off at 06:00pm at Pierre Baudis Congress Centre**
